:Like ADVENT, LENT is a special time to pray and fast and prepare for a major Christian celebration. Advent, of course, is for Christmas, LENT is for the resurrection. In the ancient Church, even funerals and weddings were forbidden in LENT. Funerals were postponed. I know that this sounds incredible but it was true.


LENT is **not** designed to make us uncomfortable. It is to help us prepare for the joys of Easter. In these days of instant gratification and fast food, we are not willing to wait or prepare for almost anything.


Yet here is a time to invest in Wednesday suppers and lessons and to renew our appreciation for the Passion of the Christ.

I pray that all of us will make the most of this season for seriousness and prayers as we come nearer to the Holy season.

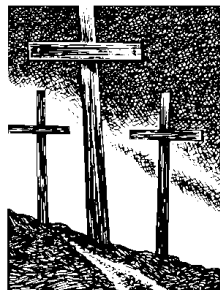

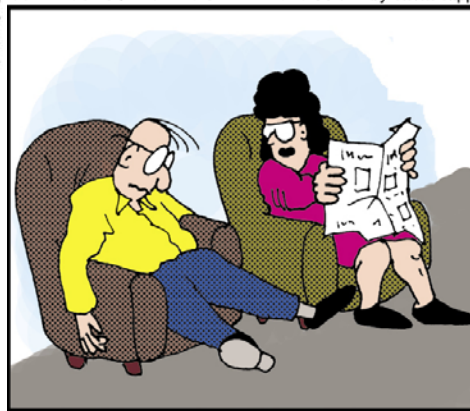

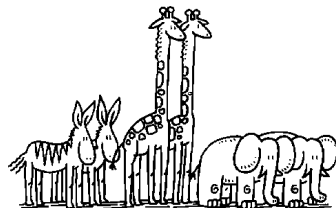
